Alpine Meadows Squaw Valley SL / SL Dec. 19-20, 2015

*****VENUE CHANGE***** The Alpine SL races are being moved to Squaw Valley on Exhibition. Alpine's Kangaroo lift providing access to the race hill blew its gearbox and cannot be repaired by this weekend. Alternate access routes were determined to not be suitable, so with the cooperation of both Alpine and Squaw's race departments and event services the venue change to neighboring Squaw was determined to be the best alternative.

The second event on the 2015 -2016 race calendar is a SL weekend at Alpine Meadows on Dec. 19-20, prior to the holiday break.
