Following a holiday break in the race schedule, Far West Masters racing resumes the second weekend of January with a Friday SL double-header on Heavenly's World Cup run. This now-classic event is hosted by FW champion John Gianotti, with the morning race counted for the annual Viva Italia cup. For the first time in many years, racing will continue through the weekend with 2 GS races on Heavenly's newly-homologated GS race hill, thanks to a renewed commitment to racing at Heavenly and a reinvigorated staff eager to host more USSA competitions.
