Heavenly Viva Italia SL / SL (rescheduled) Friday March 3, 2017

The Heavenly SL races that were cancelled due to weather on the first weekend of January (the start of #JanuBuried!) have been rescheduled on Friday Mar. 3, the day before our scheduled GS races at Mt. Rose on Sat-Sun Mar. 4-5. With the relatively close proximity of Heavenly and Rose on the south/east side of Tahoe, this should allow a reasonable travel plan for competitors.

We will be racing on the World Cup SL run at the California base of Heavenly.
