The opening event of the 2016 -2017 Far West Masters race season will feature two SL races and one GS race at Mammoth Mountain. Mammoth provides a reliable early season race venue, along with a week-long training camp prior to the race weekend, so this is a great kickoff to open the season. Mammoth will also host a DH/SG speed racing event in January and the annual Masters National Championships on March 13-18.
