Northstar parking: upper parking lots adjacent to the Village are PAID only (Viillage View lots, preferred parking). Competitors must be a current member of US Ski and Snowboard and Far West Masters. New racers are welcome and may purchase a short-term US Ski and Snowboard membership license per race day.

Directions to Competition Services office for checkin

Walk past the True North store, access is through the double glass doors opposite "Frites" by the ice rink to the right of the Demo Shop. **Enter towards Restrooms, turn left, go through double yellow doors and directly in front is access to the NorthStar Competition Services office.

There will be sandwich direction boards out in the walkway from the corner also giving direction.
