



# Granite Chief Far West Masters Ski Racing Series

Feb. 28-Mar. 1 (*rescheduled from 2/21-22*)

Our originally scheduled SG/SG weekend at Northstar for the weekend of Feb. 21-22 had to be cancelled due to lack of coverage on portions of the race hill. The races have been rescheduled for the following weekend Feb. 28-Mar 1 and all entries received for the original race dates have been applied to the rescheduled race dates. Our rescheduled races coincide with a previously scheduled Sierra League Sat. SG clinic and Sun. SG race. Sierra League in conjunction with the Northstar race department have graciously accommodated the addition of our event. (Far West Masters thanks both Sierra League and Northstar!) Please bear in mind that our usual schedule is consequently adjusted to accommodate both groups.

We welcome all Sierra League racers and others to sign up – if you do not have a USSA masters competition license, for event insurance purposes you will need to sign up for a \$25 USSA weekend competition license – forms will be available at registration or can be printed from the [online form](#).

Because of the overlapping events, it will **not** be possible to have a training run prior to the race as originally planned. However, on Saturday masters competitors are welcomed to sign up for the Sierra League SG clinic in the morning (9-11am). The Sunday schedule is inspection, with the masters race start at approximately 10:15 following the Sierra run and as needed a redress of the course. Please remember that schedule is subject to change due to weather and snow conditions, as always.
