Open class competitors: if you are competing for Open class season points, remember that the DH and SG races follow FW rules: you must ELECT PRIOR TO THE RACE if you wish to compete in Open class (no later than the day prior to the event); WOP runs after all other women's classes, MOP after all other men's classes.

Helmets are required for all disciplines!
