Mammoth is offering a special discounted group lodging rate for competitors – please see the organizer's race announcement for details. Open SG training for competitors will be provided by the Mammoth Race Department on Thursday afternoon from 12-2:30, in addition to the timed training run for all competitors on Friday morning prior to the first race.

Open class competitors: if you are competing for Open class season points (and you know who are!), please note that the two NSS races will be held using standard national masters rules, i.e., no OP class. The remaining 3 SG races will follow FW rules: you must ELECT PRIOR TO THE RACE if you wish to compete in Open class (no later than the day prior to the opening of the weekend event); WOP will run after all other women's classes and MOP will run after all other men's age classes.

Helmets are required for all disciplines!

Competitors must be a current member of USSA and Far West Masters. New racers are welcome and may obtain an inexpensive one-time weekend competition license. Information about membership is available on our http://farwestmasters.org web site or by contacting us at membership@farwestmasters.org.
