Northstar Season Finals DH / SG / SG Apr. 11-12, 2012

The season finale for the 2011-2012 race season will be a "finals circus" on Tahoe's North Shore, featuring races in all 4 alpine disciplines at Northstar and Sugar Bowl, the season finals banquet to celebrate the conclusion of the racing season with friends and family, and a Sunday "fun race" dual with racers, family, and scholarship athletes sponsored by the Far West Masters Athlete Development Program.

The speed events will be held at Northstar on Tue-Wed Apr. 11-12. On Tuesday there will be a mandatory DH training run followed by one DH race. (The original schedule of DH training on Monday with two DH races on Tuesday has been modified to preserve the track and provide the best possible race conditions). On Wednesday there will be two SG races.
