The slow skiing zones are there for the safety and enjoyment of **all** skiers and as racers we must remember that our comfort zone for the speed at which we are in control can be intimidating to other skiers on the hill. So please limit your fast skiing to the proper areas, or better yet, the race course(s).

Helmets are required for all disciplines!
