Squaw Valley Bernard Cup SL / SL / GS Feb. 20-21, 2016

The 2016 Bernard Cup, held annually at Squaw Valley, home area of masters founder Bob Bernard, will feature 3 races in 2 days. The overall weekend title for the Bernard Cup goes to the fastest man and women based on Bob's age-handicapping formula.

We will have 2 SL races on Saturday and one GS race on Sunday. The race will be held at the Julia's Gold Race Arena at the base of Squaw Valley, accessed from the Exhibition lift. Lifts and inspection open at 8:30 both days; first run start will be at **9:30 AM** each day.
