Squaw Valley Bernard Cup SL / GS Jan. 12-13, 2019

January racing in the Far West resumes with a bang in January with the classic Squaw Valley Bernard Cup races on the second weekend of January immediately following the Friday Viva Italia Cup SL races at Heavenly.

The 2019 Bernard Cup, held annually at Squaw Valley, home area of masters founder Bob Bernard, will combine a Saturday SL and Sunday GS to determine the winners of the overall age-handicapped Bernard Cup trophy.

***** IMPORTANT ***** Squaw Valley Liability Release **must** be signed by all competitors at race checkin! If you have not signed the competition release form you will **NOT** be permitted to start!!!

REMINDER: race day checkin is required!! You **must** check in on race day to confirm your participation and ensure you receive any updates about the event program.

Helmets are required for all disciplines!

******* 2019: FIS-certified race helmet is *recommended* for GS, SG, and DH *******

Competitors must be a current member of US Ski and Snowboard and Far West Masters. New racers are welcome and may purchase an inexpensive short-term US Ski and Snowboard membership license per race day.
