The Buck Thys Memorial race brings us together to remember one of our finest masters competitors and the patriarch of an amazing Squaw Valley ski racing family, who left us with the wise words "All snow is good snow!"

Perhaps fittingly, this race will also be the 2019 Bernard Cup trophy event, using an age-handicapped formula to name the overall man and woman champion. Buck was the 2002 winner of the Bernard Cup, a fine accomplishment while competing in the men's 70's class that season.
