Mammoth Speed Series DHx2 / SGx2 / SGx2 Jan. 20-23, 2022

Our January speed event at Mammoth Mountain CA on Jan. 20-23 kicks off the 2022 masters National Speed Series (NSS) with two DH races on Thu-Fri and two SG races each day on Saturday and Sunday. DH training on Thursday is a mandatory part of the DH event; all competitors must start at least 1 training run to be eligible to race.

The first DH race on Friday and the first SG race on Saturday are scored in the National Speed Series.
