The FIS Masters Cup races at Beaver Creek, CO on Feb. 4-6 are also the Western Region Championships. Competitors age 30+ must have a current FIS Masters license; competitors 29 and under are eligible only for US masters awards. All competitors must have a current US Masters membership.

The 2022 Masters National Championships are tentatively scheduled at Sun Valley ID on March 21-26; final schedule and event details will be forthcoming. Plans for the national championship DH have not yet been determined.

Additional details along with information on training opportunities will be published in the fall. Mammoth Mountain will once again be holding a masters training camp on Wed-Fri Dec 1-3, prior to our season opening SL races on Dec. 4-5.
