LIFT TICKETS	Epic Pass or Lift tickets can be purchased at the Season pass office located in the Northstar village, open at 7:45 AM. Athlete Event Day lift tickets for 13 years of age at up will be \$62 and for 12 years of age and under will be \$43. An Additional waiver will need to be signed at the ticket office. Parents/ Non racers who would like to spectate during the event.
