From Bryce Eller, first year J-2, from Mammoth:



The resulting "hard pack" was firm (or slick, depending upon your outlook), presenting all of us with challenging conditions.

The first two days of racing were on Payday, with a sunny Super-Combined on day one, followed by a Super G on day two. With mid-slope clouds and fog, the SG race finally got off after noon when the visibility improved a bit. The next two days moved over to the Eagle Race arena, with the GS run on CB's, a very steep, long, and firm pitch. The slalom took place on Picabo's, also steep and firm on the top, sharing the same run-out with CB's. This made inspection interesting, to say the least, as while we older folks and women were inspecting, the younger men were racing, and vice versa.

All in all, Far West racers skied well in some very competitive races, and some even came away with coveted race vest...congratulations Marietta, Marcie Pettigrew, and Charlene Braga for winning the combined for their class!
