Sunday River National Championships

Only a handful of FW Masters made the trek to Sunday River, Maine to compete in the National Championships, but those few made their mark!

In the Downhill, **Marietta Frinell** and **Deb Lewis** competed, with Deb having two of the fastest training times, followed by a crash in the DH race, resulting in a hand injury. Marietta gained a gold in the DH, and also took the gold combined, while Deb went on to take gold in the SG, silver overall in her class, and both made the Spyder National Masters Team.

Bob Davis, competing in a tough class, took 3rd overall with solid runs in GS, SG, and Slalom. **Ara Papazian** took gold with the fastest SG time, and **Don Smith** took a bronze in the downhill, and completed all of his races, finishing (4th?) overall in his class. **Buck Thys** and **Russ Probert** also competed well in their classes.

Next year's National Championship will take place in Sun Valley, Idaho, from March 28 to April 1. The 4th event will not be a downhill, but a super-combined. The National Downhill Championship is currently scheduled to coincide with the Aspen Downhill (on Tiehack Mountain), during the month of February. For those of us who enjoy downhills, the separation (in time and place) from the traditional National Championships is a real downer. I hope that future Nationals will return to our traditional format.

The Western Regional is scheduled to return to Park City in late January.


